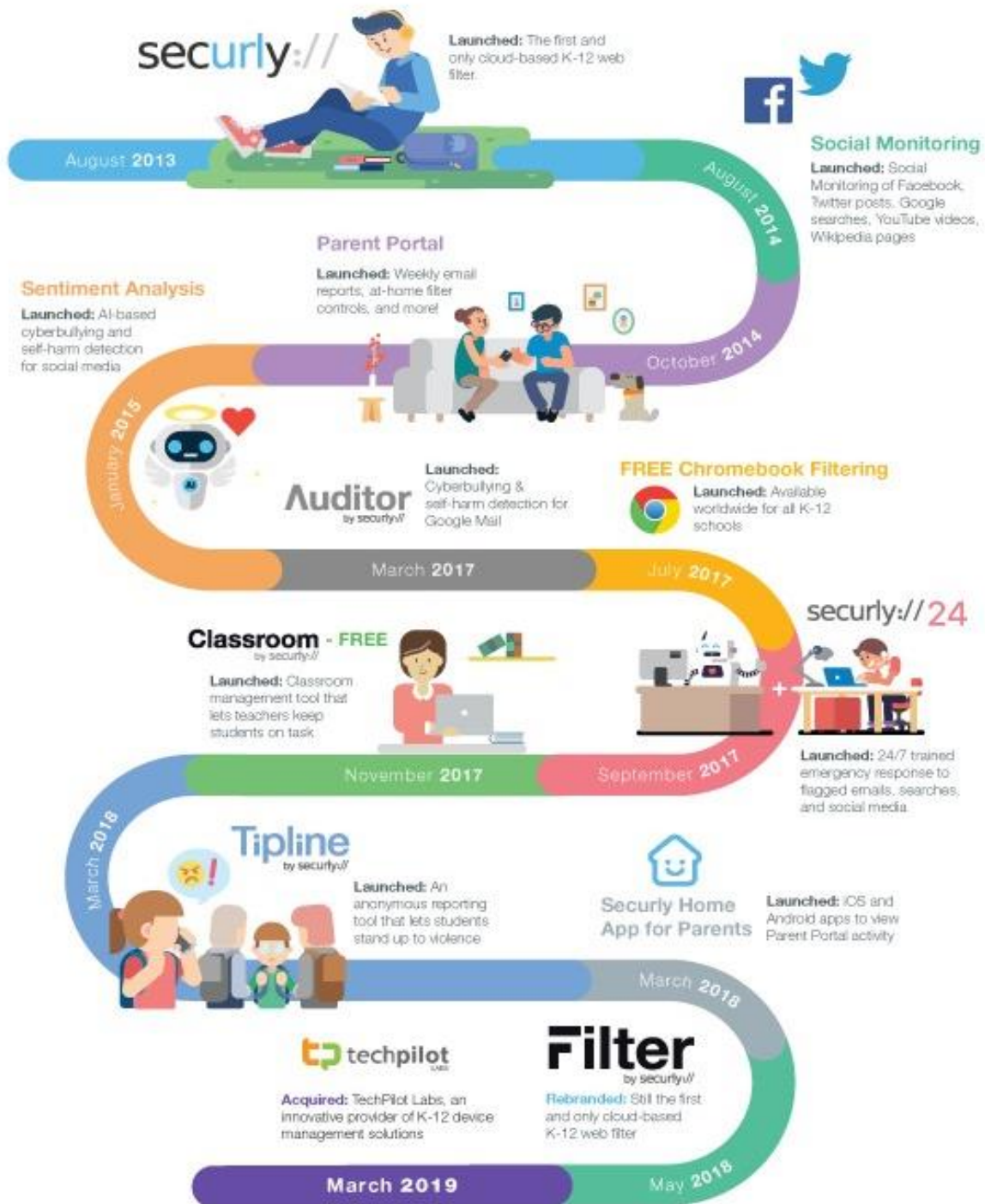
Bharath MADHUSUDAN
